DISCUSSION:

At the February 15, 2022, meeting, the City Council approved the renaming of Baseball Diamond 2 at Nicholl Park to the Willie Mays Baseball Field and holding a dedication (Willie Mays Day). During a site visit, the San Francisco Giants committed to fund the refurbishing of Fields 1 and 2. Due to the inclusion of refurbishing Field 1, the San Francisco Giants requested that the City rename both fields in honor of Willie Mays.

In conjunction with the dedication of the Willie Mays Baseball Fields, the Recreation and Parks Commission recommends the installation of a freestanding commemorative kiosk to honor Willie Mays. The kiosk will have a photo and brief description of why Mr. Mays is being honored.


The commission envisions the Willie Mays Commemorative Kiosk as the first of several kiosks that will become a Walk of Honor to recognize local heroes. The commission will develop a criteria and application process to install additional kiosks in the future. The Willie Mays kiosk is the inaugural structure.

The location of the kiosk will be at the opening of Nicholl Baseball Field 1 on the cement platform. The Parks and Landscaping Division has been consulted and will install the kiosk. The unveiling will be held on May 21, 2022, at Nicholl Park at 11:00 AM. A rendering of the kiosk is attached.

The Recreation and Parks Commission would like to thank the San Francisco Giants and the Hurlbut Benevolent Foundation for their significant contributions to the Willie Mays Day Project. Other city departments that were instrumental in coordination, include Parks and Landscaping, the Community Services Division, the Mayor's Office, KCRT and the City Council Office. This project could not have been completed without the excellent work of city staff.
