

ORDINANCE NO. N.S.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND
AMENDING CHAPTER 7.04 TO THE CITY OF RICHMOND MUNICIPAL CODE
ENTITLED “BUSINESS LICENSES”**

The City Council of the City of Richmond do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7.04.210 of the City of Richmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to add Section 7.04.210 (E)(3) to read as follows:

3. Any person owning four or fewer residential rental units under this Section may receive a credit from their gross receipts tax obligation under this Section in an amount equal to the Rent Board fees paid to the City during the same period, upon demonstration in writing and approved by the City Manager or their designee that such fees were paid in a timely manner.

SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance irrespective of the unconstitutionality or invalidity of any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance becomes effective thirty (30) days after its final passage and adoption.
