A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
APPROVING THE LOCAL ROADWAY SAFETY PLAN

WHEREAS, the Highway Safety Improvement Program serves as a vital source of funds for the City to implement safety measures to reduce traffic fatalities and serious injuries on local streets; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation has established the criteria that in order to remain eligible for future Highway Safety Improvement Program funds, local cities and counties must develop a Local Roadway Safety Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond requested, and was granted, state funds to develop the City's Local Roadway Safety Plan; and

WHEREAS, City staff worked with a traffic engineering consultant who conducted a safety analysis, investigating collision records from 2015-2019 to describe historic collision trends and identify high-risk locations, and developed collision trends, a high injury network, collision profiles, a countermeasure toolbox, and four priority project locations; and

WHEREAS, the plan was developed with a stakeholder group that included representatives from City Council as well as staff from Community Development, Fire, Police, and Public Works Departments; and

WHEREAS, City staff and consultants engaged the public via both online and in-person community workshops, included plan outreach in the Travel Safe Richmond website, and made presentations to the Richmond Neighborhood Coordinating Council as well as neighborhood councils; and

WHEREAS, the project team developed the vision statement "traffic safety impacts the health and comfort of all those who live and travel in the City of Richmond and the implementation of this plan is a step towards making the transportation system safer and more equitable for users of all transportation modes"; and

WHEREAS, the Local Roadway Safety Plan (**Attachment 1**) will serve as a framework for the City to identify, analyze, and prioritize safety improvements on local streets and will render the City eligible for future federal Highway Safety Improvement Program funds; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2022, City staff and consultants presented the Local Roadway Safety Plan to the City Council and received their feedback.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby approves the Local Roadway Safety Plan and authorizes the City Manager, or designee, to implement the plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution take effect immediately upon its passage.
