STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE:	John Chris Dupin is applying for the City of Richmond's vacant seat on the Contra Costa Mosquito and Vector Control District's Board of Trustees.

John Chris Dupin is a retired journalist and lab technician. John was a journalist for several publications covering shipping and other industries. John worked as a laboratory technician in the Entomology Department of Rutgers University while earning

a biology degree. John took several entomology courses and the lab John worked in tested mosquitoes for resistance to pesticide as well as conducting basic research. John collected mosquitos and reared their eggs into mosquito larvae, which were then tested for larvicide resistance. John retired in 2020 as a reporter for American Shipper.
