## DISCUSSION:

The Richmond Public Library has been awarded a Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, Title II (WIOA II) grant in the total amount of $\$ 50,945$, which will provide funds to support the Literacy for Every Adult Program's adult learner and family literacy services. The services include one-on-one and small group instruction to adult learners who desire to develop literacy skills.
