STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE:	The Pema Chodron Foundation is providing a donation in the amount of \$10,000 to provide general support for the Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) Operation Peacemaker Fellowship supported by ONS street outreach efforts.
RECOMMENDED ACTION:	ACCEPT and APPROPRIATE a \$10,000 donation from the Pema Chodron Foundation to the Office of Neighborhood Safety Operation Peacemaker Fellowship program – Library and Community Services Department (LaShonda White/Sam Vaughn 510-620-5404).

DISCUSSION:

The Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) has been given a donation in the amount of \$5,000 in 2020 and \$5,000 in 2021 totaling \$10,000 from the Pema Chodron Foundation (PCF) to provide general operating support for the ONS Operation Peacemaker Fellowship program. The funds will be used to provide supportive services and emergency services for Richmond youth most likely to be affected and/or confronted by gun violence. The funds were received by the City and this City Council action will authorize ONS to appropriate and utilize the funds.
