SUBJECT:	Budget Appropriation for Osprey Bird Sculpture Project
FINANCIAL IMPACT:	Funds were received in Fiscal Year 2021-2022 (13564165-400201-36002).
PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION:	November 2, 2021, and April 19, 2022
STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE:	Funds were received by the City to sculpt and install a full-size osprey bird cast in metal for the Ridgeline Property Group. City staff are now seeking the appropriation of the funds to be used in the current fiscal year.
RECOMMENDED ACTION:	APPROPRIATE into the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Public Art Percent for Art Fund budget the \$25,500 received in Fiscal Year 2021-2022 from Ridgeline Property Group for the design, fabrication, and installation of the Osprey Bird Sculpture – City Manager’s Office (Shasa Curl/Winifred Day 510-672-2209).

DISCUSSION:

The Ridgeline Property Group Developers (“Developer”) worked with the Public Art Advisory Committee (PAAC) in 2021 to solicit and select a local artist to commission an Osprey Bird sculpture. The Developer provided two in lieu of contributions to the City in the amounts of \$65,000 and \$20,000, for a total contribution of \$85,000. City staff brought forth two items to City Council, on November 2, 2021, and April 19, 2022, to accept and appropriate the funds into the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget.

It was originally anticipated that the artist would complete the project by the end of fiscal year 2021-2022. However, the project experienced delays pushing the completion date into the current fiscal year. City staff is now requesting that the previously received funds in the amount of \$25,500 be appropriated to the current fiscal year.
