DISCUSSION:

The Contra Costa Transportation Authority (CCTA) is a public agency formed by Contra Costa voters in 1988 to manage the county's transportation sales tax program and to oversee countywide transportation planning efforts. In addition to planning, funding, and

delivering the transportation projects and programs the voters approved, CCTA also serves as the county's congestion management agency and long-range transportation planning agency. This is an update to the Richmond City Council on the programs and projects CCTA is currently working on and the agency's vision for the future.
