OPERATIONAL AGREEMENT STAND! For Families Free of Violence &

the City of Richmond Police Department

This Operational Agreement stands as evidence that STAND! for Families Free of Violence (STAND!) and the City of Richmond intend to work together toward the mutual goal of providing maximum available assistance for crime victims residing in Richmond. To this end, each agency agrees to collaborate by coordinating/providing the following services for domestic violence victims and their families residing in the City of Richmond:

Emergency Shelter; 24-hour Crisis Line; legal advocacy and referral services; Transitional Housing; children's advocacy in the Shelter; emergency support for victims; child/youth and adult counseling and support groups; domestic violence treatment programs; employment development; and youth and adult education and prevention programs.

In addition, STAND! agrees to:

- Assess the needs of victims and create a safety plan for each;
- Support victims throughout the criminal justice process and advocate for victims within the criminal justice system;
- Provide victims and their children with Emergency Shelter, food, clothing, and transportation;
- Provide counseling, support, and legal advocacy to the victim, as necessary.

The City of Richmond Police Department agrees to:

- Refer victims of domestic violence to STAND!;
- Make abatement of domestic violence one of its concerns;
- Meet with STAND! staff when available to review and improve coordination of services for victims of domestic violence.

This agreement shall be effective for a period beginning July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025. We, the undersigned, as authorized representatives of STAND! For Families Free of Violence and the City of Richmond Police Department, do hereby approve this document.
