**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE GRANT AWARD
PROVIDED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE BYRNE COMMUNITY
PROJECT GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 FOR THE 2023-2027 PERIOD.**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond’s Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) desires to receive grant funds provided by the U.S. Department of Justice Byrne Discretionary Community Project.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) will provide violence intervention, prevention, and suppression activities services through the U.S. Department of Justice Byrne Discretionary Community Project grant in an effort to reduce violence through evidence-based programs and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council accepts and appropriates the grant award from the U.S. Department of Justice Byrne Discretionary Community Project in the amount of \$300,000 for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2027 to provide supportive services and stipend support for the Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) Operation Peacemaker Fellowship supported by ONS street outreach efforts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Richmond’s Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) agrees to all terms required by the U.S. Department of Justice Byrne Discretionary Community Project grant to fulfill the obligations of this grant award.
