

~~SECOND~~ AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR LEGAL SERVICES
BETWEEN

OPPENHEIMER INVESTIGATIONS GROUP LLP

This Second Amendment to the legal services agreement between the City of Richmond, (“City”), and **OPPENHEIMER INVESTIGATIONS GROUP LLP** comprised of attorneys who conduct personnel investigations (“Investigators”) (the “Second Amendment”) is entered into as of **JULY 1, 2023** by and between the City and Investigators with reference to the following facts:

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Investigators entered into that certain Legal Services Agreement (“Original Agreement”) for representation of the City and City-related entities; and

WHEREAS, the City now desires for Investigators to continue its representation of the City and to extend the term of the agreement to JUNE 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City and Investigators now desire for Investigators to include Tina Ro-Connolly, Tracey Merwise, Danielle Drossel, Ilona Turner, Jack Morse, Erik Roper, Rachel Reddick, Sandy Fu, Renee Jansen, Madeline Buitelaar, Ashlyn Clark, Maria Walker, Garrett Smith, Jeanette Boykins and Neil Bautista in its representation of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City and Investigators desire to amend the Original Agreement pursuant to this Second Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals hereof, and other mutual covenants and promises contained herein and for other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the City and Investigators agree as follows:

1. Amendment. Exhibit A of the Original Agreement, “Scope of Work and Schedule of Fees & Charges,” is hereby amended to read as shown in Attachment 1 to this Second Amendment.
2. Effect of Second Amendment. Except as provided in this Second Amendment, all other terms of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
3. Counterparts. This Second Amendment may be executed in counterparts each of which shall be an original and all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument.
