STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE:	Ana Tellez Witrago is applying to serve on the Community Police Review Commission
RECOMMENDED ACTION:	APPOINT Ana Tellez Witrago to the Community Police Review Commission to fill a vacant seat with an unexpired term ending November 1, 2027 – Mayor’s Office (Mayor Eduardo Martinez 510-620-6503).

DISCUSSION:

Ana Tellez-Witrago is a long-time Richmond resident. She has a strong belief in the mission of the Community Police Review Commission and emphasizes the importance of listening to community members who feel they have been unfairly or unjustly treated by law enforcement. She highlights the Commission’s role in holding the police department accountable and fostering trust between residents and public safety institutions. Ms. Tellez-Witrago’s long-standing connection to Richmond, combined with her commitment to accountability and community trust, would bring valuable perspective to the Community Police Review Commission.
