STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE:	In 1978, the school district of Sonoma, California recognized Women's History Week to highlight the contributions of women to events in history and contemporary society. In 1980, President Jimmy Carter issued a presidential proclamation recognizing Women's History Week, which was followed by the United States Congress recognizing Women's History Week in 1981 and Women's History Month in 1987.
