## DISCUSSION:

On June 16, 2020, Michael Cervantes was appointed to seat #3 on the Human Rights and Human Relations Commission and resigned from his seat. Megan Sanchez is being appointed to fill the unexpired term left by Mr. Cervantes. Ms. Sanchez is a Richmond resident and full-time student. Her term will expire on March 30, 2023.

Jason Woody is being appointed to seat #9 for his first term on the Human Rights/Human Relations Commission. Mr. Woody is the Community Development Director for Rich City Rides. His term will expire on March 30, 2025.
