**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO  
ACCEPT A NEW FEDERAL GRANT AWARD PASSED THROUGH THE STATE OF  
CALIFORNIA EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND TO ADJUST  
APPROPRIATIONS EXPENDITURES IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022  
EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET.**

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the City of Richmond fiscal year 2021-2022 operating budget, the Employment and Training Department was awarded \$250,000 from the California Employment Development Department Dislocated Youth Worker Innovation Challenge (DYWIC) Program funding, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$250,000 will be used to provide Richmond residents who are participating in the State's Dislocated Youth Worker Innovation Challenge program with occupational skills training and on-the-job training opportunities, and

**WHEREAS**, this new grant will significantly expand access to training and job placement opportunities for Richmond residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the fiscal year 2021-2022 Employment and Training budget is adjusted to add \$250,000 to revenue and to add \$250,000 to expenditures.
