DISCUSSION:

Fernando Campos is being appointed to seat #2 for his first term on the Workforce Development Board. Mr. Campos is employed with the LiUNA Local 324 as a Business Representative/Political Director and fulfills the labor, joint-management apprenticeship programs, community-based, and youth-serving organizations partner requirement per the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act. His term will expire September 22, 2026.

Wesley Alexander is being appointed to seat #8 for his first term on the Workforce Development Board. Mr. Alexander is the CEO of CoBiz Richmond, Inc. and fulfills the government, economic development and community partner requirement per the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act. His term will expire March 1, 2026.
